Important Info!

Who can go: Youth do not have to be currently enrolled in 4-H. Camp is for youth ages 9-14 OR who have completed 3rd grade.

Adult Counselors: Any adult/parent interested in attending camp should contact the Extension Office for a registration packet immediately. All adult volunteers must complete a screening process if selected. There is no charge for adults selected to attend!

<u>Teen Counselors</u>: Any teen (15-17) interested in attending camp should contact the Extension Office for a registration packet immediately!

There is no charge for teens who are selected to attend!

How to Sign Up: Camp deposit (\$20) is DUE NO LATER THAN JUNE 13th. SPACE IS LIMITED. Once your deposit is paid, your spot will be secured. Registration packets and remainder of payment will be DUE NO LATER THAN June 20th. Cash and checks accepted. Make checks payable to Lawrence County 4-H.

<u>Lodging & Meals:</u> Camp registration is \$100. This includes meals, lodging, transportation, a camp t-shirt, and activities at camp.



<u>Health Forms:</u> We require you to provide all health information. We do not require a physical. Campers must submit a copy of his/her Medical Insurance Card WHEN TURNING IN CAMP REGISTRATION FORMS.



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Lemon Broccoli Pasta

Prep time: 15 minutes Cook time: 25 minutes

- 1 box (16 ounces)
 whole-wheat pasta
 (rotini, spaghetti, bowtie,
 elbow macaroni)
- 1 package (12 to 14 ounces) frozen broccoli
- Zest of one lemon
- Juice of one lemon (about 2 tablespoons of lemon juice)
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 2 1/2 teaspoons garlic powder or 1 clove of garlic, minced
- 2 cups spinach
- 1 cup grated parmesan cheese
- 1 cup reserved pasta water
- Salt and pepper, to taste
- Wash hands with warm water and soap, scrubbing for at least 20 seconds.
- Boil water and prepare pasta according to package directions. Be sure to save 1 cup of pasta water for later use.

- While the pasta cooks, microwave broccoli for about 5 minutes, or until thawed.
- In a large saucepan over medium heat, add oil and sauté broccoli for 3-5 minutes.
- 5. Add cooked pasta to the saucepan with the broccoli. Add lemon zest, lemon juice, garlic, spinach, and reserved pasta water. Use tongs or a spoon to evenly combine everything. Cook until spinach is wilted, about 5 minutes.
- 6. Sprinkle over parmesan cheese and stir to combine. Reduce heat to low and cook for an additional 3 to 5 minutes or until it reaches desired texture.
- 7. Serve.
- 8. Refrigerate leftovers within 2 hours.
